Commercial vessel means a vessel in commercial use and carrying cargo and/or passengers for reward (including charter)

Pleasure craft means any craft used for sport or pleasure by the owner and where there is no financial gain

- Notes**
1. Commercial vessel under 5 metres includes jet skis and Vendors Licence from Ministry of Tourism is required for these
 2. Watersports craft that operate from resorts with a rescue boat in attendance do not require ADOMS marking but shall be marked with resorts own Identification
 3. Local Sports FV Licence, or Local Recreational FV Licence also required from Fisheries Division
 4. Pleasure non powered craft under 5 metres includes kayaks, canoes, paddleboats, paddleboards, windsurf/sailboards and sailing boats
 5. Where there is no ISM system in place the Small Craft declaration is required
